In the same Order, the Commission has set the instant applications for jurisdictional hearing on February 9, 2010.

During the February 9, 2010 hearing, ZAMSURECO I appeared and presented its proof of compliance with the Commission's posting and publication of notice requirements which were duly marked as exhibits.

Another hearing is hereby set for expository presentation, pre-trial conference and evidentiary hearing on July 7, 2010 (Wednesday) at ten o'clock in the morning (10:00 A.M.) at the ZAMSURECO I Main Office, Hero's Hall, J.S. Alano St., Pagadian City, Zamboanga del Sur.

ZAMSURECO I is hereby directed to cause the publication of the attached Notice of Public Hearing, at its own expense, once (1x) in a newspaper of general circulation in the Philippines, with the date of the publication to be made not later than five (5) days before the date of the scheduled hearing. It is also directed to inform the consumers within its franchise area, by any other means available and appropriate, of the filing of the instant applications, its reasons therefor and of the scheduled hearing thereon.

Let copies of this Order and the attached Notice of Public Hearing be furnished the Office of the Solicitor General (OSG), the Commission on Audit (COA) and the Committees on Energy of both Houses of Congress. They are hereby requested, if they so desire, to send their duly authorized representatives at the scheduled hearing.

Likewise, let copies of this Order and the attached Notice of Public Hearing be furnished the Offices of the Governors of the Provinces of Zamboanga Del Sur and Misamis Occidental and the Offices of the Mayors of the City and Municipalities within ZAMSURECO I's franchise area for the appropriate posting thereof on their respective bulletin boards.

ZAMSURECO I is hereby directed to furnish all those making requests therefor with copies of the applications and their attachments, subject to reimbursement of reasonable photocopying costs.

On the date of the scheduled hearing, ZAMSURECO I must submit to the Commission its written compliance with the aforesaid directives attaching therewith, methodically arranged and duly marked, the evidence on the actual posting and publication of the Notice of Public Hearing consisting of certifications issued to that effect, signed by the aforementioned Governors and Mayors or their duly authorized

representatives, bearing the seals of their offices, and the affidavit of the Editor or Business Manager of the newspaper where the said Notice of Public Hearing will be published together with the complete issue of the said newspaper, and such other proofs of compliance with the requirements of the Commission.

ZAMSURECO I and all other interested parties are directed to submit, at least five (5) days before the date of initial hearing and pre-trial conference, their respective Pre-trial Briefs containing, among others:

- (a) a summary of admitted facts and proposed stipulation of facts;
- (b) the issues to be tried or resolved;
- (c) the documents or exhibits to be presented, stating the purposes thereof and proposed markings therefore; and
- (d) the number and names of the witnesses, with their written testimonies in an individual affidavit form, to be attached to the Pre-trial Brief.

Failure of ZAMSURECO I to submit the required Pre-Trial Brief and Judicial Affidavits of its witnesses within the prescribed period shall be a ground for cancellation of the scheduled hearing, and the resetting of which shall be six (6) months from said date of cancellation.


As part of the pre-trial conference, ZAMSURECO I must also be prepared to make an expository presentation on its applications, aided by whatever communication medium that it may deem appropriate for the purpose, in order to put in plain words and explain, for the benefit of the consumers and other concerned parties, what the applications are all about and the reasons and justifications being cited in support of the rate adjustments prayed for.

Finally, ZAMSURECO I is hereby required, at its expense, to prepare the transcripts of the proceedings from the official recordings of the Commission and submit such within five (5) days from each scheduled hearing. The submitted transcripts shall be subjected to verification and certification by the Commission that the contents thereof are true and correct and faithfully reflects the official recordings. The certified transcripts shall then be deemed as official part of the records of the case.
